



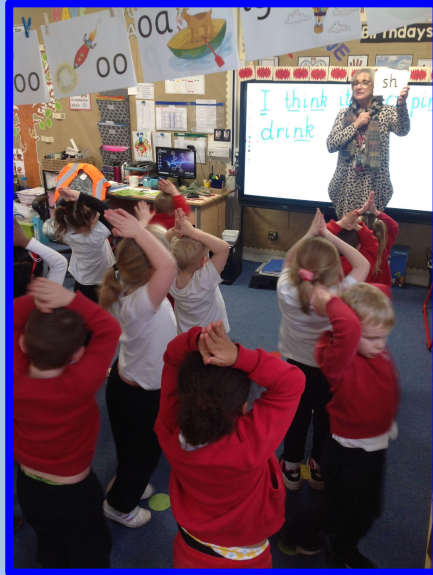

How Song of Sounds helps the children:

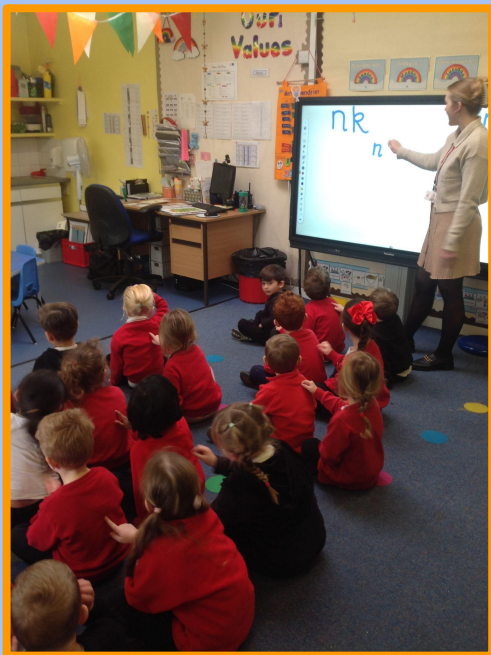
“It helps me with

How Song of Sounds helps the children:



“If I need a word that has one of our sounds I use them to help me spell. If I didn’t know them I wouldn’t be able to spell.”

How Song of Sounds helps the children:



“It reminds me what sounds to put in my spelling. When I spell saw I know it is s-aw and if I can’t remember I can look at song of sounds around the room or the sound mat. If it is not there I can sing the song. ”
