

Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2017

In 2016, the new, more challenging curriculum, which was introduced in 2014, was assessed by new tests. Results are no longer reported as levels: each pupil receives their test results as a scaled score. The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above.

Because of the changes set out above, figures from 2016 onwards are not comparable to those for earlier years. The expectations for pupils at the end of key stage 2 have been raised. Given the differences in the curriculum and assessments, levels are not comparable with scaled scores therefore the school's previous end of key stage 2 results are not included.
