



Key Stage 2 SATs Results 2016

“2016 was the first year of the new Key Stage 2 tests in maths, reading and grammar, punctuation and spelling. The tests assess children against a national standard... As the new standard is higher than the old one, fewer children have met the new expected standard than the previous standard.”
